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reveals the little known history of one of history's most famous maps and its maker tucked away in a near forgotten collection. Virginia and Maryland as it is planted and inhabited is one of the most extraordinary maps of colonial British America created by a colonial merchant planter and diplomat named Augustine Herrman. The map pictures the mid Atlantic in breathtaking detail capturing its waterways, coastlines and communities. Herrman spent three decades travelling between Dutch New Amsterdam and the English Chesapeake before eventually settling in Maryland and making this map. Although the map has been reproduced widely, the history of how it became one of the most famous images of the Chesapeake has never been told. A biography of a map in motion uncovers the intertwined stories of the map and its maker, offering new insights into the creation of empire in North America. The book follows the map from the waterways of the Chesapeake to the workshops of London where it was turned into a print and sold, transported into coffee houses, private rooms and government offices. Virginia and Maryland became an apparatus of empire that allowed English elites to imaginatively possess and accurately manage their Atlantic colonies. Investigating this map offers the rare opportunity to recapture the complementary and occasionally conflicting forces that created the British empire from the colonial and the metropolitan to the economic and the political to the local and the Atlantic. This is a fascinating exploration of the many meanings of a map and how what some saw as establishing a sense of local place could translate to forging an empire.

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What contemporary prostate angst tells us about how we understand masculinity, aging and sexuality. She describes current biomedical approaches, reports on the discovery of the prostate in the

sixteenth century and its later appearance as both medical object and discursive trope and explores present day diagnostic practices for benign prostate hyperplasia which transform a process urination into a thing the prostate turning to the most anxiety provoking prostate worry prostate cancer johnson discusses psa screening and the vulnerabilities it awakens or sometimes silences and then considers the presence of the absent prostate how the prostate continues to affect lives after it has been removed in the name of health

biography as a literary genre is largely the product of the eighteenth century and of one seminal work James Boswell's *Life of Samuel Johnson* 1791 Boswell's innovations revolutionized the genre and made it the target of suppression and censorship he sought not only to memorialize a great man but also to reveal his flaws Boswell reported long stretches of Johnson's conversation noted his mannerisms and in general gave an intimate picture such as no biography had ever before dared to attempt after Boswell there was a retreat from his bolder innovations which amounted to self censorship on the biographer's part when Thomas Carlyle's biographer James Anthony Froude braved this trend against truth and allowed his subject's dark side to show he was vilified in the press the tensions between discretion and candor have endured in British biography since Froude a point Carl Rollyson makes in the reviews of contemporary British biographers he includes in British biography which also contains Johnson's full length biography of Richard Savage excerpts from Boswell's *Life of Johnson* as well selections from and commentaries on Southey's biography of Nelson Mrs Gaskell's biography of Charlotte Brontë and the revolutionary work of Froude and Strachey
