in order to not only learn to speak the language but also to understand the grammar rules that can be applied to sentence constructions in different contexts this book teaches the lebanese accent however it s very close to the spoken arabic of syria jordan and palestine as they all speak levantine arabic dialects to help the reader better understand the grammar rules english explanation is provided afterwards in addition to an english translation of the texts this textbook also contains pictures to help visual learners memorize the vocabulary through association in this textbook latin letters are used to make pronunciation easier since the main purpose is to target speaking only and not reading or writing the language
